NB The Enemy having drawn off all their Cannon & sent them back to Donway continued still in the same Camp about three Quarters of a League from us; the Troops with Prince Eugene return'd to the Siege and a part of the Dutch foot marched towards the right to occupy some of the Ground where the imperial foot had been 30 Sq. of B. Eugene's Army under command of Count Schik encamp't behind our Army in a Readiness to join us or P. Eugene as there should be Occasion.
