

Brig: Landsperg to march to encamp at Courtray with six Battalions a Colonel to those likewise with 800 Horse, they are to receive their Orders from my Lord Duke, The Battalions to Assemble at P. Albrechts at noon. The Commanders of Reg^{ts} to cause the Orders to be often called to keep the Men at home each nation to Forrage with their own Escorts and to send their IMs to Night to M^r Cadoganis for a disposition. The Officers of each Corps who go with the Forragers to answer for all disorders, no body to cut down Trees in Avenues. It is particularly ordered that all those, whether General Officers or others who have any Waggon's belonging to the Country do return them at two this Afternoon to the Artillery where there will be a Commissary to receive them. 150 Men to be lightly Cloathed at Salish Regiment at 4 this Afternoon, the Generals of the day to see that good Communications be kept between the Regiments. M. Gen^l Villats Court Martial to attend him to morrow at nine in the Morning, The English are to Forrage the Villages Bondues, Lenselles, & Deulmont 3 Captains & 300 Men for Escorts to be at the Artillery at break of day Colonel Spotswood will give them orders, the Forragers at nine in the Morning at same place where Guides are

MB My Lord Duke having foreseen the Difficulties of getting a Convoy from Bruxelles and that the delay at the Siege wasted much ammunition had sent private Orders to prepare necessities for a Convoy at Ostend and expecting every day Accounts of M^r Earls landing there that we might keep a communication and take up a post at Audenburgh and Seefinght to secure the Convoys thought necessary to make a Detachment from the Army, which the better to conceal his design from the Enemy was to be done by degrees, and this day Brigadier Lansperg with
