We continued to pass with tollerable success our amunition hitherto  
to not much disturbed. This Evening the Major who was posted  
at Weynendael having sent word that the Enemy were marching  
with their Army towards Koklaer from Aetricht, Mr Fagle was  
immediately ordered to march with 20 Batt to succour Mr Cadogan  
who was posted at Koklaer and Peters Capelle but this proved  
a false alarm and the Reg<sup>t</sup>s were countermanded, however since  
the Enemy had so great a Body at Oudenborg and on the other  
side of the Canal about Bridges it was thought proper to send  
a greater Body towards Mr Cadogan.
