We continued to pass with tollerable success our ammunition hither
to not much disturbed. This Evening the Major who was Posted
at Weynendael having sent word that the Enemy were marching
with their Army towards Koklaer from Atricht, M. Hagler was
immediately ordered to march with 20 Batt. to Succour M. Cadogan
who was Posted at Koklaer and Peter Capelle but this proved
a false Alarm and the Regts. were Countermanded, however since
the Enemy had so great a Body at Cudenburg and on the other
side of the Canal about Bridges it was thought proper to send
a greater Body towards M. Cadogan.
