On Pain of Death nobody to out of Camp a Foraging till farther orders. all Commandants to answer for this, the Commanders of Companies to make a search for Corn in the Tents and what's found to be brought to the Colours, they shall receive 12 Shillings for each Sack, Officers who have any shall receive the same a Lt Gen^l. a Maj Gen^l. 2 Brig^d. with 16 Batt^l. to be commanded to Assemble on the other side of the Roufplaer in the Ipres Road at break of day to morrow to take only their Tents and bare Horses, The Lt Gen^l. Lt Orkney, This Detach^t. was Countermanded.

NB Corn begining to grow very scarce, strict orders were given against foraging of Grain and that all should be brought into the Magazines each Soldier or Trooper was paid 12 Shillings of Sack. Lt Orkney was commanded with a Detach^t. of 16 Batt^l. and some Sq^{rs}. to march to block up Ipres till the Horse should go all round the Country to carry off what Corn they could find but the Detach^t. was countmanded in night upon some other project the Gen^l. gave to My Lt Duke for getting Corn.
