

the other side of the River to Attack the redoubt at Montaigne which was done but upon their approach to the Barrier the Enemy abandoned it and retired over the Scheldt having had 3 or 4 Cannon shot fired at them, then a Detachment was sent after some Boats going up the Scheldt with hay for the Enemy which took them. The prince of Orange possessed himself of St Amand letting the Garrison go off. ordered to keep themselves ready to march and having left a sufficient Command at these places they joined the Army at Willemean the 28th in the afternoon

WB... Mons^r De Dompne with his body of Troops invested Tournay on Mount Trinity side, and Mons Lumley with 40 Squadrons passed the upper Scheldt near Antoine to invest it that way. The Enemy were much surprized at this sudden change we gave to Mons^r De Villers for they did not expect at all to be besieged at Tournay. They rather feared Ipres, for we to cover our design brought our Cannon up the Liff as far as Courtray. There are 11 Battalions & 5 or 6 Squadrons in Garrison in Tournay.
