The Baggage of the right wing to be at one this afternoon, behind the British Artillery. The Gen^l Officers of the day to be at 4 this afternoon at my Lord Dukes for further Orders. At 4 in the afternoon ordered 40 Squadrons with all the Dr^{ms} at 6 to night at Albermarles Carbiniers. The Baggage that is not gone, to be sent away as fast as possible To march at mid night without Drum or Trumpet. The posts in the Front to be retired to night and those in the Road to Tournay to come off with the rear Guard of the Army.

This morning we had Accounts that the Enemy had again beat the Chamade to surrender the Citadel as prisoners but desired some mark of honour. The heavy Baggage was immediately ordered away and the Prince of Hesse Cassel was detached with 40 Squadrons from our Army and 20 from Prince Eugene's and all the Dr^{ms}. The Army marched at midnight The left wing towards Mortaigne and the right towards Anthoine. Prince Eugene's Army marched at the same time tow^d the Scheld between Anthoine and Tournay.
