The wounded that were not able of being transported to Bruxelles were sent to St guillaun, The States sent Orders to bring out fresh Battalions from their Garrisons and several of those who suffered most were sent into Garrison. We had Account that the Enemys foot after the Battle were much divided and seperated in the Retreat some going towards Manbegne a Brigade towards Conde and 3 brigades were at the gates of Valen. crennes next Morning, after the Battle, Their corps de Battaille went between Guesnoye and Valenciennes where their Army now is
