MB This Detachment was made for the Siege under the command of the Prince of Orange, Lieut. Genl. Cadogan went to Bruxelles to hasten the Artillery, a new Camp was marked. The right for Prince Eugene near Gemappe his left coming to Norchin (or Noirchin) and our Army running from thence by Flawent and before Givray towards Mespis Nicol.

The General to beat at 7 to morrow morning and to march to the New Ground at 10, to send all the Baggage before that nothing stop the March. The Drums for the Siege to be immediately at the Abby of Belian. The orders against Maroding to be read at the head of every Regiment and Squadron to morrow, and on Sunday Orders to be given out to morrow at eleven at the Line.

MB. The Bread Waggon not being come, that the remaining part of the wounded might be transported. The Army delayed to move till to morrow.
