 and 2 Battalions, Lieut. Genl. Cadogan who went to view the
 opening of Ground of this Attack where the English are to be
 employed was wounded by a Shot in the neck and his Aid de
 Camp mortally wounded. Hill's Regiment was at the opening
 Lieut. Col. Clayton was ill wounded and at both Attacks there
 was about 50 Men killed and wounded.
