Orders will be given out for the future at the Prince of Oranges at 10. for the opening the Trenches this night at 7. The Battalions following are to parade in the rear of Salish's Regiment viz: Earl, Mordaunt Salish and Ghor at the same time & place 600 Fusileers with a Colonel and Officers in proportion for covering the Workmen. 2700 for Work with 2 Col: and Officers in proportion to parade as above. They are to be relieved to morrow morning by a Col: & 1350 Workmen. The Trenches to be relieved to morrow at 6 at night

WB The Trenches were opened at Dunoy by 2 Attacks, Lord Orkney commanded at the opening of the ground at the Prince of Oranges Attack with Maj: Gen: Wassenaar & Brig Primrose and the Battalions and Coverers mentioned in the Orders. Tho it was very late before every thing was right posted & the Men begun to Work yet we were very well covered before the Enemy found us out and by day light had made a very good Trench for
