

Six Waggon or Carts of each Regiment to be in the Rear of the Besieging Army at break of day to go to Tournay for Ammunition to receive orders from the Lieut. Col. of the Dutch Train to receive Forrage (Gratis) while there and 150 Guilders will be paid for any horse killed or Spoiled. The Church of Gurichy to be taken up for the Sick of the British, each Regiment to send a Sergeant and some Men to get Straw for it. At the Retreat, The Pickets of the Battalions to March to reinforce the Trenches a Field Officer and 60 Workmen to night, relieved to morrow by 400. For the Batterys 600, relieved by 400 & 200 to carry fascines

10th. The Regiments for the Trenches to day are Sabine, Govain, May and Metrail and to morrow Spinnrose, Hamilton, Schmidt and Debruil, The Regiments to be always upon the Parade exactly at 6 in the Morning. The reinforce of Picket to be as last night. 600 Workmen to night to be relieved in the Morning by 400. For the Battery 500 relieved by 300.

The Regiments for the Trenches to morrow, Sutton, Salisches Orange and Tecklenburg. Suttons to be relieved from y^e Siege by that of Prestons and to change their Ground at Conweniency to night 600 Workmen relieved in the Morning by 400. For the Batterys 500. relieved by the same number and 200 for carrying Fascines to be relieved by 400. The Workmen that go from the Trenches without leave are to be punished besides are not to be paid for their Work. The Gen^{ls} that are not upon the Trenches to take henceforth the Orders of the day
