

Order of the March from the Camp at Lens to that of Honal 19th July

The Army Files off by the right and Marches in 3 Columns in the following manner viz! The Cavalry of the right Wing files off by the right in 2 Columns, the first line on the left and the 2^d on the right and having passed the Soucett on the Bridges made at the Village Seanville continue their March through the Plain to the Camp leaving the Villages of Bully, Sain, Hersin, & Barlin on the left and the 2 Columns of Infantry at the right wing always at the right.

The Infantry of the right wing Files off by the right in two Columns. The first line on the left and the 2^d on the right, and pass the Bridges made between Seanville and Lens continuing their March through the plain to the camp, leaving the 2 Columns of Cavalry of the right wing on their left, and the 2 Columns of their Infantry of the left wing always on their right. The Infantry of the left wing files off by the right in 2 Columns the first line on the left and the 2^d on the right they pass the Soucett on the Bridges made between the Villages of Moyelles and Fougieres continuing their March through the plain to the camp. Having the 2 Columns of Infantry of the right wing on their left and the 2 Columns of Cavalry off the left wing on their right. The Cavalry of the left Wing files off by the right in two Columns the 1st line on the left and the second on the right. They pass the Soucett at the Bridges made at Stern continuing their March through the Plain to the Camp having the 2 Columns of Infantry of the left on their left & the 2 Trains of Artillery on their right.

Artillery. The 2 Trains of Artillery marches at 3 this Afternoon Having passed through the Town of Lens draw up near the Abbye of Anay and stay there all night and march to morrow at the same time the Army does. The British Train first by Hollands next.
