

700 with 4 days bread to night at 5 at Labafree. Order of March
to Monon to Cotte. The Army Files off by the right and Marches in
8 Columns as follows viz: The Cavalry of the right in 2 Columns
by the right the 1st Line on the left and the 2^d on their Right and
pass the Lake on Bridges made between Jern Bridge and y^e Castle
of Bronay and so through the Plain towards the Village of Marle
where they pass the Clay cence on Bridges made at forsd Village
and continue their March through the plain on the other side
to the Camp leaving the Villages of Lalonne & Hamblin Gallin
on their left and the 2 Columns of Infantry of the right wing al-
ways on their right. The Infantry of the right wing Files off by
the right in 2 Columns the first line to the left the 2^d on their
right and march through the plain to the Chateau de Bronay &
pass the Lake on the bridges made. and thence thro the plain on the
other side and pass the Clay cence on the Bridges made between
Marle and Wee Marle continuing their March through the
Plain to the Camp having the second Column of Cavalry of the
right wing on the left and the 2 Columns of Infantry at the left
wing on the right. The Infantry of the left wing Files off by the
right in 2 Columns and March throu the plain behind the
Encampment of the right Wing to pass the Lake on the Bridges
made between Bronay and Boufsiere and having got on the
plain on the other side they pass the Clay cence on the Bridges
made between Marle and Wee Marle and continue their March
throu the plains to the Camp having the 2 Columns of Infantry
of the right wing on their left and the 2 Columns of Cavalry of the
left wing on their right. The Cavalry of the left wing Files off
by the right in 2 Columns and march through the plain
towards the Village of Boufsiere where they pass the Lake the
first line on the Bridges that are made & the 2^d on the Stone bridge
and
