

The Bridges made continuing their March through y^e plains on the other side to the Camp, having always the two Columns of the Infantry of the right wing on their left. The Infantry of the right wing marches by the left in 2 Columns as it is encamped the first line on the right and the 2^d on their left through the Plain by the Overtures that are made to the Chateau & Divion where they pass the Bridges that are made for them, and thence through the plain on the other side to the Camp having always the right wing of Convabry on their right and the Infantry of their left wing on their left.

The Infantry of the left wing marches by the left in two Columns the first line on the right and the 2^d on their left thro the Plain by the Overtures to the Chateau de Divion when they pass the Brook in the Bridges made for them, continuing their March through the plain on the other side to the Camp having always the Infantry of the right wing on their right and the Cavalry of the left wing on their left. The Cavalry of the left wing marches in 2 Columns by the left through the plain by the Overtures to the Chateau de Divion where they pass the Brook on the Bridges made for them continuing their March thro the plain on the other side to the Camp having always the Infantry of the left wing on their right.

The Dr^{ums} of the right with the new Grand Guard & 200 horse at 3 in the Morning at Rantrais Regiment of Hannover foot camped on the left of the right wing &c. The Dr^{ums} of the left with the new Grand Guard and 200 horse at 3 on the high road that passes by the Chateau Camblin Catelain called les pruniers &c.
