

right on their left. The Infantry of the right files off by the right in 2 Columns as it is encamped. The first line on the left and the 2^d on their right, thro the Plains in the Front of the Camp to their Ground having the Columns of Cavalry of the right on their right and the 2 Columns of Infantry of the left on their left. The Infantry of the left wing file off by the left in 2 Columns, the first line on the right and the second on their left and March through the plain to Viller brulave where they enter into their Camp having always the Columns of Infantry of the right wing on their right and the two Columns of Cavalry of the left on their left.

The Cavalry of the left wing file off by the left in 2 Columns as they are incamped the 1st line on the right and the 2^d on their left through the plains towards Beton saart where they come into their Camp, having the 2 Columns of Infantry of the left on their right.

The British Artillery follows the March of the right wing and the Hollands that of the Left. The Baggage Waggons follow their respective Artilleries. The Dth of the right with the new Grand Guard and 500 Horse at 4 in the Morning at 1st Battalion of Orkneys where the Dth are.

Those of the left with the New Grand Guard and 500 Horse at 4 at Leib's Regiment of Danish horse at the left of the first line where 4th. The old Grand Guard to be the rear Guards of each wing, 2 Field Officers of each wing commanded with the Dth viz: one of Foot and one of Horse who are to keep the Camp bolousmen together that they commit no disorders, nor plunder Villages.
