of the camp they are to get on the plain of Grand Servin and leaving the Village of Grand and petit Servin on their left. They pass the hollow way of Larency and leaving the said Village of Larency on their left they are to get on the plain on the other side continuing their March through the said Plain to the Camp, leaving the Villages of Brebieres and Arleux on their left and the 2 Columns of the right wing on their right.

The right wing files off by the left in 2 columns as they are encamp'd. The first line on the right and the 2<sup>d</sup> on their left each line begining by one of the Battalions of Rentravis hanover Foot, taking right towards the Village of Viller an bois. The first line passes the Wood through the overtures the 2<sup>d</sup> by the high Road & so march through the plain towards Nenville. It Vast for to go past the Scarp between Vitry & Brebieres from thence continuing their March through the plains on the other side to their camp leaving the Villages of Viller an Bois, Gavrel & Vitry on <sup>the</sup> right and the 2 columns of the left wing on their left.

*Artillery* The 2 Artilleries march at 9 at Night. The Hollands first and the British next followed by all the Baggage by the great road that goes by Dix en go. alle to Seanette near Lens where they pass the Souchette continuing their March through the great Woods that goes through Ignechin to Corbe hen where they pass the Scarp from thence to pass the canall at Arleux on <sup>the</sup> Bridges to be made, and come into their camp

*Pontoon* The Pontoon marches at the head of their Respective Artilleries and having passed the Souchette near Lens are to go before, The Hollands Escorted by 100 horse to the right towards Vitry there to make Bridges on the Scarp and these of British go also before Escorted by 100 horse passing through Donay to make Bridges on the Canal of Arlenst above Guelzin.
