Order of March from Vergiere to Avenne Le seeg. The Army marches off by the left and Marches in 4 Columns after the following manner. The left wing marches off by the left in 2 Columns and marches right towards Union where they pass the Scheldt on the Bridges made to come into the Camp, having the 2 Columns of the right wing on their right. The right wing Files off by the left in 2 Columns beginning by the 2 Battalions of Rantaus. They march through the plain on the Front of the left wing to Union where they pass the Scheldt upon the Bridges that are made for them to come into their Camp having the
