Foot in the first line as also a Major Genl. Brigadier and 1500  
horse to morrow morning at two at Brilos Regiment of Horse  
the Horse and foot are to be Posted in the following manner.

At the Village of Sallsoy 100 foot. 200 foot between Sallsoy & Montre-  
court, 100 foot in Montrecourt, 300 foot between Montrecourt and  
Brete, 100 at Brete 300 foot between Brete & Neuville, 100 foot  
at Neuville and 400 foot between Neuville and Monton, all  
these are to guard the side of the Selle, to hinder the Foragers to  
pass the said River and that the Enemy do not come with the  
Escort. At the Mill of St Vast 50 horse. 350 horse between Monton  
and Reumont on the height by Chateau Cambressis to observe  
the Enemy from Sandrecy. 100 horse between Reumont & Honnechy  
100 horse between Honnechy & Berties on the height between Ber-  
ties and Ardençour. 700 horse to observe the Enemy from Cambrai  
and Crevecan. 100 foot at Guivri, 200 foot at the Chateau de Cler-  
mont. 100 foot at St Hilary. 50 horse on the height of Bevillers. 50  
horse between St Hilary and the camp on the height of Avennes  
les Auberts. 100 foot in the Village of Avenne les Auberts and 400  
in Chateau Cambressis

The Foragers to be at the head of their Regiments at 5 in the  
Morning and march the right wing filing off by the left leaving  
the Village of Bevillers on their right, are to go forage in the  
Villages of Bertie, Honnechy and Trois Villers. The left wing  
filing off by the right March through the plain to St Hilary from  
thence by Valley, to the villages of Inchy, Beaumont, Reumont &  
Morro where they are to Forage. The Generals for the foot are  
Lieut. Genl. Gersdorp, Maj<sup>o</sup>. Genl. Du Troussell and Brigadier  
Hompeſſe and Prestons.
