The D of O's Army gives six Battalions a Major Genl and a Brigadier whereof two March to morrow the 25th to camp between Thurne and Nivelles where they will join the three of the Prince's Army and the other 4 are to be the 26th in the Morning at the Windmill of Hellemmes where they are to join the four Battalions of the Prince's Army & the Detachment of Cavalry.

The General who Commands the whole Detachment is to send a Major General and a Brigadier to Command the 5 Battalions
