

the plain and leaving the Village of Abscon on their right are to go towards Lourche where they shall pass the Scheld on the Bridges that are made and having got on the Plain on the other side shall continue their March through the said Plain to the camp having always the Army of the P^{of} S on their right and the two columns of the left wing on their left.

The two Columns of the left file off by the left the first line to the right the second on their left and are to march towards the Village of Dourche where they are to pass the Scheld on the Bridges that are made and having got on the plain on the other side are to continue their march through the said plain to the camp having always the two Columns of the right wing on their right and the River Selle on their left.

The Train of Artillery are to begin their March half an hour after the Army and to take the road that goes from the camp to Lourche where they are to pass the Scheld as soon as the two Columns of the left are passed and to follow the March of these two Columns to the camp, all the great Baggage are to be assembled this night at six by the British train and are to follow the March of the said Train to morrow to the camp.

The Quarter Masters with the new grand guard are to be at Midnight at the head of North's Regiment of British foot camped in the first line, where the Quarter Master Gen^l will come to conduct them.

There will be 600 Horse commanded to be at Midnight at the head of North's Regiment camped in the first line to March with the Quarter Masters.
