

Army files off by the left in eight columns after the following manner.

The Cavalry of the left wing files off by the left in two columns the line beginning with the Regiment of Württemberg Cels and the second by the left Regiment Saxe, they are to pass the Selle the first line by the Ford the second by the Bridge at Neuville and shall continue their March to the camp, The Cavalry of the right wing files off by the left in two columns the first line beginning at the Regiment of Vandernat and the second by the Regiment of Hatten these two columns are to march thro the plain To pass the Selle by the Fords and the Village of Briatte and to continue their March through the plain into their camp having always the two columns of Cavalry of the left wing on their right and the two columns of Infantry on their left

The two columns of the Infantry of the left wing file off by the left the first line beginning with the Danish Guards the second line by the Saxe Guards, these two columns should march thro the Plain to pass the Selle on the Bridges will be made between the Villages of Briat and Solenne and having got on the plain on the other side shall come into their camp having always the two columns of the right wing of Cavalry on their right and the two columns of Infantry of the right wing on their left

The two columns of Infantry of the right wing files off by the left the first line beginning by Orrery's Regiment & the second by Grumkows these two columns are to march through the plain to pass the Selle on the Bridges that are made by Sollemmes where they enter into their camp having always the two columns of the left wing of infantry on their right and the Artillery and Baggage on their left
