

All the Forragers are to be ready at the head of their Regiments at four in the Morning and are to file off by the left of the Line in two Columns the first line leaving the Village of Oisij on their right where they fall into the Forrage. Officers as Ordinary must be Commanded with the Forragers. A Major Genl^d must be Commanded with the foot & a Brigadier with the Horse

50 Hussars must be Commanded to March with the Horse who are to patrol to Guise and return by Nouvish to Bergues where they are to join the Escort, The Grand Guards on the left are to advance to the Hauteur by the Arbre de Bassiau to secure the Forragers in coming home

Is expressly forbidden all Forragers as well Officers Servants as others to go out with the Escort. No Forragers or others are to pluck down or go into houses on pain of death.
