500 from the beuse de Marcoigny along the Road that crosses the
Corner of the Wood going towards Bohain
- 200 from the foresaid Road along the side of the Wood to the
Village of Audigny
- 200 in the Village of Audigny
- The Officers commanding the above Posts are to take care
to let no Forragers go into the Woods and to hinder the Enemy's
parties to come into the Forrage
- 100 In the Village of St Souple
- 50 At St Martin Riviere
- 200 Between St Martin & Molain
- 150 To guard the side of the Brook from Molain to Vaux en Arvoise
- 200 In the Village of Vaux

Foot 3000 The Officers commanding all these Posts are to take care
that the Forragers dont pass the Selte and that none of the
Enemies parties come into the Forrage

There must also be Commanded 1000 horse who are to
parade at midnight at the head of Reg^t Wurttemberg Cts
from whence they will be led to take up the following posts

- 100 On the Hauteur de Massinghein to observe what may come
from Guise or Landreux
- 50 At the Windmill of Waisigny
- 50 At the Windmill of Vaux
- 800 In little Squad: across the plain from the Village of Vaux
to the Village Audigny

The Officers commanding these posts are to hinder the
Forragers to run into the Wood of Bohain

The Forragers are to be at the head of their Regiments
at four in the Morning filing off by the left in 2 Columns
are to be led the first line to the Village St. Martin the second
to
