There must also be Commanded a Brigadier & 1200 horse, who
are to be at the head of Bulcoot dragoons at midnight and from
thence they will be led to the following Posts

- 100 Between La Brigueterie and St. Pierre
- 500 At the Windmill of Ors Stretching along the Road that goes from
Foillion to Landrechy
- 200 In small Troops between the hauteur between Châtillon & Bassieux
to secure the Forragers when they return
- 100 Between Ors and the Grand bois de l' eveque

horse 1200 There must also be Commanded eight pontoons to be at the head
of Bulco's at four in the Afternoon to march with the Infantry.

All the Forragers are to be ready at the head of their respective Reg.^{ts}
at five in the Morning they are to file off by the left in two Columns
the first line is to be led to the Village of Châtillon the Second to Ors
where they pass the Sambre to come into the Forrage, there must be
commanded with the Forragers Officers as usual who are to take
great care to prevent all disorders.

It is expressly forbidden that any Forragers go out with the Escort
No Forragers to go into the Houses or plunder them, the general
Provost will be sent with 50 horse to hang all he finds disobeying
these Orders
