The Army Forrages to morrow between the Villages of Busigni and Marai. For to make this Forrage there must be Commanded a Lieut^{nt} Genl. two Maj^{rs} Genls two Brigadiers 4500 foot & 1500 horse who are to parade at the head of the British Guards at half an hour after four this afternoon from whence they will be led to take up the following Posts.

- 200 foot to guard the side of the Selle to the Village of St Souple
- 1000 on the Road that goes from St Souple to the Bois de Busigni
- 1000 guarding the side of the Wood all along to Busigni
- 300 in Busigni
- 500 Between Busigni and Malmaison
- 700 from Malmaison all along the corner of the Wood towards Marai
- 500 At the Village of Marai
- 200 At the Village of Honechi
- 100 At the Village of Reumont

- 100 horse to be posted in 3 squadrons on the hauteur between St Souple and the Beuse de Bois
- 100 between Busigni and Malmaison in the Ouverture between the two Woods
- 500 between the corner of the Wood from Malmaison to Marai
- 600 between Marai and Honechi
- 200 between Honechi and Reumont

All the Officers Commanding the above written Posts are to take care to hinder the Forragers from going without the Escort and that the Enemy's parties dont come into the Forrage

All The Forragers are to be ready at the head of their respective Regiments at five in the Morning and are to be led into two columns filing off by the Right to pass the Selle at the
