The Artillery to march from their camp at five in the Morning and having past the Scheld upon the Bridge made above Newville shall draw up and halt till the line of foot be past and then shall fall in the rear of the Line of horse and follow the same to the camp.

All the heavy baggage to follow the March of the Artillery

The Quartermasters with a Detachment of 50 horse for a new grand Guard to parade at the head of my Lord Stairs Regiment at three in the Morning where they shall receive the Orders of the Quartermaster Generals. A Detachment of 200 foot and 30 horse to parade at the head of the Artillery at four in the morning to Escort the Artillery and baggage and assist the Waggon Master

All the Troops encamp't near Denain to march at five in the morning and to join the Army near Swardes

The Genl: to beat at four and the Army to begin their March at five. The present Grand Guard to make the rear Guard of all.

If any person shall be found straggling before the Quarter Masters or the Army he shall be whipt by the provost and those who shall go into any Villages to plunder, burn, or force safe Guards shall be hanged, of which the Commanding Officers of each Regiment is to give notice to his Men
