

in the Country, the Sick not able to march are to be brought to point Arache there to wait the Hospital boats coming from Douay and to be transported by them, An Officer of the whole to be Commanded to take care of the Sick

Order of March commanded by his Grace the Duke of Armond to go from the Camp at Plines to l'hospital of Themolin to morrow the 19th July 1712

The Army is to March from the right in one Column the two lines of horse first and foot afterwards.

The 1st Line of Horse is to File off from the right and to take the great Road to Tournay which passes by Courtiches & Archie & to continue their March by the same Road unto the Camp.

The second line of Horse is to file off from the right & follow the March of the first line

The first line of foot is to file off from the right and follow the march of the second line of horse, The second line of Foot is to file off from the right and to follow the March of the first line of Foot. The heavy Baggage is to assemble behind the Artillery at four in the Morning and to follow the same to the Camp

A Detachment of 200 foot is to be Commanded to march with the Artillery and 30 horse with the heavy Baggage which Detachments must be at the head of the Artillery to morrow morning at three o'clock.

The Quarter Masters with the new Grand Guard to beat three in the Morning at the head of my Lord Stairs Regiment of Dragoons, the Old Grand guard to make the Rear Guard of the whole

The orders against murthering and plundering to be published again and the Provost to be sent out as usual.

The General to beat at 4 in the Morning and the Army to March
