at times for example we had 71 Pieces of 24
in Battery & 4, 4 mortars and there was always
600 men commanded at the Batteries who had
Half a Crown a day,
for the Cohorns there was a man commanded to each
mortar, with a 100 a Captⁿ & two Subalterns
