Take a potell of red wine and a potell of milk of it
a red cow of pearle amber get and curell of ech
and ounce and 5 or 6 peces of gould beat all the
hard things saving the gould m to powder and s-
till them in a limback and draw a pint and a
halfe of water

And exelent Salve for a greene wound

Take uenas terpentime and wash it well in rose w-
ater and worke it well with a sponne then poure away
the water and put to it as much oyle of roses as you
think fit and temper it well together a gaine then put
it in a boxe and when you wold use any of it temper a
a lited of the yelke of an eye with it and spread
