The subscriber respectfully begs leave to call the attention of the Board to the fact that when going to Philadelphia last Spring I was requested by the Executive Committee to make such inquiries as would seem to me proper, and to take such measures as would seem to me promising for the obtainment of a Military Instructor for the State University. Also to visit such colleges &c. as would enable me to report my judgment regarding a suitable person for permanent president of the faculty &c. &c.

The manner in which those duties have been performed is embodied in my report of the 6th of July, 1867. And to the consideration of this report it is that I have been instructed to call the present meeting of the Board.

In addition, I beg leave to say that since the meeting of the Executive Committee, the following gentlemen have been recommended, - any one of whom in the judgment of your subscriber is fully competent to supply the places and chairs spoken of. For president of the Faculty, 1st - the Rev. Mr. Yaffan, late president of the University of Michigan; 2nd - also Rev. Mr. Bourns, president of the University at Northfield, Vt.; 3d - Edward P. Evans, Ph. D., Prof. of Modern Languages and Literature in the University of Michigan; 4th - Rev. James R. Boise, A. M., Prof. of the Greek Language & Literature in the University of Michigan; and 5th - Henry S. Frieze, A. M., Prof. of Latin Language & Literature in the University of Michigan.
