Annual meeting of the Board of Regents of University of Kansas, Lawrence, Dec. 4th, 1867, 2 o'clock, P. M.

Treas' report

for 1866 The auditor of the Board, C. B. Lines, reported that the report of the Treasurer for the year ending Dec. 31st, 1866, having been returned to him, upon examination was found correct.

The following resolution was offered by H. P. Mitchell, and was adopted:

Resolved - That it is the judgment of the Board that under the law the Chancellor of the University is the president of the faculty -

On motion of H. P. Mitchell the Board entered into an election for a Chancellor for the University.

At 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ o'clock while election was pending the Board adjourned for a noon till 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ o'clock.

At 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ o'clock the Board met and was called to order by the president appointed for this meeting, S. O. Thacher.

The election for a Chancellor resulted in the choice of Gen. John Fraser, President of the Agricultural College of Pennsylvania.
