 accepted.

Chas. Robinson offered the following resolution which was
 adopted:

Resolved; That Professors Horner, Robinson and Snow
 be paid seventy-five dollars each in addition to the \$1525-
 paid them by the State Treasurer — out of any money in the
 Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

On motion of C. B. Lines it was voted to make the
 fiscal year commence with the Academic year on the first
 day of July.

On motion of J. L. Weaver, the Exec. Com., with the Chan-
 cellor, was instructed to frame By-laws for conducting the bu-
 sines of the Board, at report to the Board at its Annual
 meeting on the 2nd Dec. prox.

On motion of C. B. Lines the Chancellor was dis-
 tinguished to take charge for the present of the studies of the Chair
 of Moral & Mental Philosophy and Belles Lettres made vacant
 by the resignation of Prof. Horner.

Board then adjourned. The Board ordered record to
 be made of the last report to State Legislature, and in con-
 nection therewith the appropriations made by the Legislature for
 the University for the present year.
