## Special Meeting

The Board met on call of building committee in Olds House, Lawrence, July 12th, at 2<sup>1/2</sup> o'clock -

The meeting was opened with prayer by C. B. Jones - Member present - The Chancellor, John Fraser, W. C. Tunney, C. B. Jones, J. L. Coover, W. P. Mitchell, E. M. Matthiessen, T. Moonlight, Charles Robinson, R. G. Elliott and W. A. Stant.

There was also present Mayor Lawrence's building committee, Members absent - F. G. Giles, J. W. Higgett, P. McGehee and T. C. Sears -

The minutes of last meeting were read and approved.

Bids for Carpenter work according to plans and specifications furnished by architect were then opened and read from three different parties.
