The Maran, W. C. Tenney, presented his report which was accepted and referred to the Board's Auditing Committee.

The Chairman of the Building Committee, Charles Robeson, reported that he had a report of the doings of the Committee, of Building which report the following is a synopsis.

Committee The lowest bidder on the masonry of New Building, Mr. Crookshank, declined to enter into a contract to do the work.

Award of Contract The Com. then notified S. W. Eldridge, the next lowest bidder of their intention of contracting with him.

June 1812, The Com. met and located the building

Location on the East side of the University grounds as follows:

Fronting East, with the centre of east front two hundred & Building fifty feet west of east line of University grounds and on the Township line.

July 2nd The Committee met and approved the contractors bond of S. W. Eldridge and contracted ^{with Eldridge & Leecher} to have the Madison Bond stonework of University done according to plans & specifications furnished by the architect for

Committee The Committee decided to meet every Saturday, meets at 11 o'clock, a. m. And way work has been paying every contractor amount due according to estimate of architect, Saturday but reserving 10 per cent as per contract.

The whole amt. paid out to Eldridge & Leecher for stone-work, H. S. Tiflar for Carpenter work, and to Architect, till date is - - - - - \$15,647.06.

At close of reading above report, the Board adjourned for a recess to visit the New Building, and to meet at Eldridge Room at 7 o'clock in the evening.

At 7 o'clock the Board convened.

Election of officers An election was, on motion, entered into, for officers for ensuing year.

W. A. Stannett was elected Secretary.

W. C. Tenney was elected Maran,

R. G. Elliott was elected Auditor, and

Prof. J. W. Snow was elected Librarian.
