The question of the creation of the two new professorships as recommended in Chancellor's report was taken up. It seemed to be the mind of the Board to include Chemistry in the first named professorships; and on motion of J. W. Vail it was voted to institute the ~~the~~ professorships of Chemistry & Physics to take effect September next, and with the same salary as the other regular professors.

On motion of same it was voted also to institute a professorship of General & Industrial Drawing, to take effect at same time and with the same salary.

It was then voted on motion of J. W. Vail to ask the increase of appropriation of over last year, as recommended in Chancellor's report, and according to a former resolution of the Board, so as to give each regular professor a salary of \$2000 per year.

The salary of the Instructor in Vocal Music was on motion of J. Moonlight fixed at \$400, and the salary of Instructor in Chemistry at \$600, and that of Instructor in Hum. Anat. & Physiology at \$400.

On motion it was voted to ask an appropriation of \$1400 for fuel for ensuing year, and for other items, ^{it was voted separately} as per recommendation in Chancellor's report, making the bill of appropriations for 1871 - as follows -
