## Annual Meeting

Lawrence, Dec. 4<sup>th</sup>, 1872 - The Board met in annual session in the new University Building at 2 o'clock p.m. Meeting opened with prayer by Dr. Mitchell.

The minutes of last meeting were read and approved. The Chancellor offered his annual report to the Board, which report was received on motion of W. P. Mitchell. The following is an abstract of the report:

The aggregate number examined in the year will probably exceed 300. The aggregate that will be enrolled will probably exceed 270. The attendance and donations have been large, but for the stringency of the money market and the fact that the new University building was not advertised as ready for use.

The University, however, holds its own, and has a proportionally large aggregate and a large actual attendance than either the State Agricultural College, or the State Normal School, both older institutions, which used to have in their entire years a large aggregate and actual attendance than the University.
