Dec 11- announced to their respective names. Have not Annual succeeded in efforts to procure names and testimonials of suitable candidates either for positions of Assistant Prof. of Chem., or of assistant in Drawing, Mathematics, & English Studies. Would recommend that a full professor of Chem. be appointed. Importance of Chemistry demands that an officer of more experience should be in charge of Chem. Dept. in which the work is very varied & extensive.

Would recommend definitive action in regard to reorganization of both Medical & Legal Dep^{ts} to be postponed for six weeks to allow opportunity to visit eminent legal and Medical instructors in the East during Christmas recess.

For information in regard to new building would request to examine and see for yourselves. For disbursements of building fund would refer to report of Chairman of building Committee.
