

1873 Record of Meetings of Board of Regents

Mar. 31 Board at the annual meeting, Dec. 4th, 1872, Special and recorded in the minutes of that meeting (which Meeting see), which reports were then referred to the auditor for examination, — endorsed as follows: — "The Treasurer's Report of the Treasurer of the University of Kansas, Dec. 4th, 1872 — General Fund" — thus:

On motion of D. P. Mitchell the Board voted to pay salary of Prof. Smith up till end of March 1873 out of the General Fund.

Mr. Lesche's extra charge of \$474.95 for building cisterns was referred to the Building Committee.

On motion of D. P. Mitchell the Board instructed the Building Committee to pay the interest now due on loan contracted with the Bank of Lawrence of \$3000, out of building fund, and to renew the same loan, if it can be done, for ninety (90) days.

The following, offered by C. B. Lewis, was adopted: Whereas it appears that there is due to sundry persons balances of various amounts, against the building fund of the University, which accounts have been, or may hereafter be, accepted, approved and ordered paid, but which cannot now be paid for want of funds, — Therefore,

Resolved: That the Treasurer of this Board be, and he is hereby, authorized and instructed to execute the obligation of this Board in its corporate capacity to each of such claimants to the full amount found to be due, with interest at 12 per cent. per annum from the time said
