

5 Resolved That the Board hold the Faculty responsible for order among the students, and for the highest possible development of the work of the University.

Judge McFarland offered the following resolution which was unanimously adopted;

Whereas the Board in the coming Academic year contemplates the completion of the University building, fencing and otherwise improving the grounds; and, whereas, the most convenient way of access to the grounds is by way of Mississippi street, therefore be it resolved that the City of Lawrence be requested to open and improve said street so as to have the same open to travel by next Commencement day.

On motion of J. A. Anderson it was "resolved that the thanks of the Board of Regents are hereby expressed to the Hon. John S. Ingalls for the able oration delivered before the University, and that a copy of the same be requested for publication.

Resolved that the Finance Committee be instructed to publish the proceedings of the first Commencement in pamphlet form.
